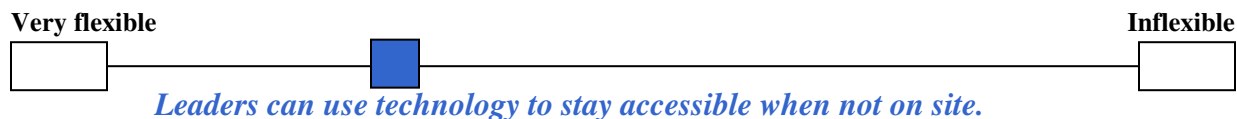


Four Ways Leaders Can Flex

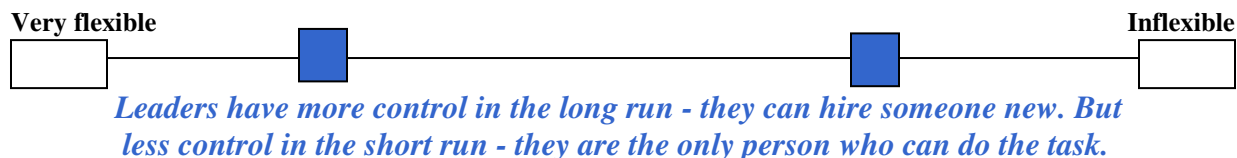
Schedule & Physical Presence – How much can you flex when/ where you work?
